

INVITING APPLICATIONS FROM NGOs FOR EMPANELMENT

The Government of India has received a grant from the GFATM Round –VI and part of the grant will be used for the purpose of enhancing HIV/AIDS-related care, support and treatment services. The Karnataka Health Promotion Trust, Bangalore has received a grant as sub-recipient, from National AIDS Control Organization (primary recipient), Ministry of health and Family Welfare, GOI to implement the Community Care Centre (CCC) project in the state of Maharashtra. The project is aimed at providing care and support services to people living with HIV/AIDS through the establishment of CCCs. The CCC will be linked to the ART centre. The components of the project are positive prevention, care, support, treatment, programme management and strategic information management. Applications are invited from interested registered NGOs experienced in the provision of health care in the field of HIV/AIDS.
