Link Worker Scheme (LWS) has been designed to intensify and consolidate the prevention services, focusing on the at-risk population in the rural areas. The Scheme aims to address complex needs of HIV prevention, care and support, in rural areas through identification and training of field level workforce of Zonal Supervisors, Cluster Link Workers and other stakeholders on issues of HIV/AIDS, gender, sexuality and Sexual Tract Infections (STI). Mobilizing difficult-to-reach, others at risk populations, such as High Risk Groups, to access the public health services for STI, HIV Counselling and Testing Centres (ICTC), Anti-Retroviral Therapy (ART) etc. are the major components of the Scheme.

KHPT invites applications for the following position for its Link Workers Scheme implementation across Karnataka.

1. District Resource Person: Positions: 4, Belgaum, Bagalkot, Bijapur and Gadag

Qualification and experience and desirable skills:

- Master's degree in social work, sociology, public health and relevant discipline
- Minimum of 7-8 years of progressively responsible professional experience in NGO sector specifically with marginalized and vulnerable population in national development organization.
- Excellent leadership and management skills
- Commitment to public health values
- Community centric attitude and skills, Commitment to quality work by self, by team
- Team management, partner management and relationship building skills
- Program management and capacity building
- Excellent written and oral communication skills in English and Local language

Roles and Responsibilities:

- Over all responsibility of the programme in the district.
- Supervise works delegated to other member of the team and mentor them.

- Facilitate recruitment of staffs as per the Guidelines in case of vacancies.
- Development of district implementation plan ensure approval by competent authorities.
- Monitor the implementation of district plan and submit progress reports as per requirement.
- Ensure training of all staffs when they join and training by STRC.
- Make field visits, meet and coordinate with stakeholders at district and block level to address issues related to implementation of the scheme.
- Support SACS/DAPCU in implementing various activities such as Condom Programme,
- Folk Media Activities, Mass Media campaigns, Health camps etc.
- Work with various government departments ensuring that the target groups are enrolled, receiving necessary services if they are eligible.
- Play key role in advocacy at all levels against stigma and discrimination.
- Compile reports and ensure analysis by M&E assistant for programmatic gaps.
- Submit programme and financial reports on time to SACS/TSU/DAPCU or any other agency.

Salary: Salary for this position is fixed as Rs. 21,000/- per month.
